Learn about the warnings signs of breast cancer. This is not limited to females; males are subject as well.

The risk of getting breast cancer increases as you age. Most breast cancers and breast cancer deaths occur in women aged 50 and older. Until more is known about prevention, early detection and treatment offer the best defense against dying from breast cancer.
